

What is the Proposed Zoning Map?

The Unified Development Code, once adopted, will govern the use and development of land within the jurisdiction of the Shreveport-Caddo Metropolitan Planning Commission (MPC). Because the UDC will include a whole new array of zoning districts, the Proposed Zoning Map has been included as part of the review and comment process. Each of the current zoning districts have been converted to its most compatible UDC zoning district (i.e. B-1 becomes C-1), except where Staff has recommended a new zoning classification be assigned as described within the UDC.

How can you view the map?

The Proposed Zoning Map can be downloaded on the [UDC website](#), or by clicking [here](#). The Map is in Adobe Acrobat format and, once downloaded, is over 17mb. To view and print the maps, you will need the most recent version of the Adobe Acrobat Reader, available for [free download](#).

Printing the entire map is not advised. Acrobat Reader's Graphics Select tool and Copy tool can be used to copy and paste a portion of the map into a word processing or graphics program. To obtain the highest quality when printing sections of proposed map, choose the "print as image" option on the Print screen.
